**Texas Insurance Code, 4001.051, Acts
Constituting “Acting as Agent”**

- (b) Regardless of whether the act is done by the request of or by the employment of an insurer, broker, or other person, a person is the agent of the insurer for which the act is done or risk is taken . . . if the person:
- (1) solicits insurance on behalf of the insurer;
 - (2) receives or transmits other than on the person’s own behalf an application for insurance or an insurance policy to or from the insurer; . . .
 - (4) receives or transmits an insurance policy of the insurer;
. . .
 - (6) receives, collects or transmits an insurance premium;
